It is our good fortune to announce the 21st Annual North Rockland Community 5K Run/Walk. This will be a day of community involvement for a wonderful cause. The community will be donating the proceeds from the 5K Run/Walk to:

Kaylee Flores –

Kaylee is a 2nd Grade student at West Haverstraw Elementary who has been diagnosed with Hereditary Spastic Paraplegia (HSP). This condition is a group of rare, inherited progressive disorders characterized by stiffness and weakness in the leg muscles caused by degeneration of nerves in the spinal cord. This affects her mobility and she therefore uses a walker and wears braces to support her legs and improve stability while walking. As time goes on, she will need more therapies, doctor appointments and tools to help her be mobile and dependent which will put a financial burden on the family.

Aliza Argamonte Melo –

Aliza is a 16-year-old 11th grader at North Rockland High School who is currently receiving home instruction while undergoing treatment for diffuse midline glioma, diagnosed in February 2025. She has bravely endured two surgeries, radiation therapy, and is now continuing her fight with chemotherapy. Aliza experiences challenging side effects, including seizures, light sensitivity, and dizziness. She lives with her mother, Naomi, and her brother and sister, who support her every step of the way. Despite her diagnosis, Aliza continues to find joy in reading, drawing, playing games, and spending time in the sunshine.

David Fabian Serrano –

David is a 13 years old who is the definition of courage. Until recently, his life moved to the rhythm of a soccer ball and laughter in the corridors of his school. However, on October 30, 2024, his world took an unexpected turn when he was diagnosed with leukemia. Despite the physical battles and difficult days, his spirit does not stop. Currently, David is in the 9th grade at North Rockland High School, demonstrating an admirable resilience in continuing with his academic dreams while facing his treatment.

The run/walk will take place on Sunday, June 7, 2026, at Bowline Point Park. The Children's Race will begin at 8:30 AM and the 5K Run/Walk will begin at 9:30 AM. Based on previous years, we are anticipating a tremendous turnout from people throughout Rockland County.

The 21st Annual North Rockland Community 5K Run/Walk will be chaired by Town of Haverstraw Supervisor Howard T. Phillips, Jr., Town of Stony Point Supervisor Amy Conklin Stamm and North Rockland Athletic Director Joseph Casarella.
